- 1 The Superintendent shall be responsible for developing, maintaining and acquiring Board
- 2 approval of a comprehensive District school safety plan and building level school safety plans (the
- 3 Emergency Preparedness Plan) regarding crisis intervention, emergency response, emergency
- 4 management, and cyber security. The Emergency Preparedness Plan shall include procedures
- for bomb threats, civil disturbances, armed intruders, earthquakes, fires, tornadoes, or other
- 6 severe weather, medical emergencies, and cyber-attacks.¹
- 7 The Principal of each school shall implement emergency preparedness drills which shall be
- 8 approved by the Superintendent. When appropriate, such drills shall be held in conjunction with
- 9 emergency response agencies.

10 FIRE AND SAFETY DRILLS

- 11 The Principal shall be responsible for ensuring that one (1) fire drill requiring full evacuation is
- held every thirty (30) school days, with two (2) fire drills to be conducted within the first thirty (30)
- full days of school. Additionally, four (4) fire safety educational announcements shall be conducted
- 14 throughout the school year.2
- 15 The Principal or his/her designee shall regularly check the quantity, locations, and conditions of
- the fire extinguishers and shall provide all school personnel instructions on how to properly use
- 17 fire extinguishers.
- 18 The Principal shall also ensure that three (3) additional safety drills are given during the school
- 19 year.3 Two (2) such drills must cover earthquakes. The drills may cover inclement weather,
- 20 earthquakes, armed intruders, or other emergency drills that do not require full evacuation. A
- 21 record of all fire or safety drills, including the time and date, shall be kept in each school's main
- office and shall be maintained for a period of five (5) years.
- 23 The Superintendent shall work with the Bartlett Police Department to develop a procedure for
- identifying the cause of any fire alarm activation. This procedure must be implemented by January
- 25 1, 2025 and shall be reviewed and updated annually thereafter.⁴

26 ANNUAL DRILLS⁵

- 27 The Principal shall ensure that the school safety team conducts each of the following type of drills
- 28 annually:
- 29 1. Armed intruder drill in coordination with local law enforcement.

- An incident command drill; and
- 2 3. An emergency bus safety drill.

3 MEDICAL EMERGENCIES/PANDEMIC FLU⁶

- 4 In the event of medical emergencies, such as a pandemic flu outbreak, school officials shall
- 5 cooperate and consult with the Shelby County Health Department, Tennessee Department of
- 6 Health, and other Bartlett emergency or healthcare providers in protecting students and the
- 7 community from further infection. The Superintendent shall develop procedures for health
- 8 emergencies in accordance with state law.

9 **AED/CPR DRILLS**⁷

- 10 The BCS School Health Coordinator shall manage a program for the use of automated external
- defibrillator (AED) in BCS schools by ensuring compliance with the laws relative to training, a
- written plan for use, notification, and maintenance and testing of devices. The written plan for
- 13 AED use shall comply with T.C.A. §68-140-404.
- 14 The BCS School Health Coordinator shall conduct annual AED and CPR training for all school
- personnel. The training shall include:
- 1. Instruction on the use of AEDs;
- Information on the location of the AEDs;
- 18 3. Information regarding the school's response plan; and
- Information identifying the school response team.
- The Principal of each school shall conduct an annual CPR drill and AED drill for school personnel
- 21 to practice the use of these life-saving measures and to evaluate the school's preparedness in
- the event of sudden cardiac arrest.
- The Principal of each school shall also conduct a CPR and AED drill so that students are aware
- of the steps that must be taken in the event of a medical emergency that requires the use of an
- 25 AED.8

26 REMOTE LEARNING DRILLS9

- 27 At least once each school year, the District shall conduct a remote learning drill to ensure that
- 28 schools, students, and parents can easily transition from in-person learning to remote learning.
- The drill shall accurately reflect the District's plan for transitioning students to remote learning in
- 30 the event of a disruption to school operations.
- 31 Students shall not be asked or required to exclusively transition to remote learning at any time
- 32 during the remote learning drill.
