Pupil-teacher ratios shall not exceed the averages outlined in state law. ${ }^{1}$ Further, individual class sizes shall not exceed the maximum allowed by state law. Class size limits may be exceeded in courses such as typewriting, junior reserve officers' training corps (JROTC), and instrumental and vocal music classes, provided that the effectiveness of the instructional program is not impaired.

## WAIVERS

The Superintendent or his/her designee may seek a waiver from the Commissioner of Education to extend career and technical education (CTE) classes in grades six through twelve (6-12), provided these class sizes do not exceed the maximum permitted for CTE classes. For grades six through eight ( $6-8$ ), the class size may be extended, but the class size and average must not exceed those set for general education classes in grades seven through twelve (7-12). ${ }^{2}$

Should Bartlett City Schools enroll displaced students because of a natural disaster, the Commissioner of Education may grant a waiver from the maximum class sizes due to such enrollment.

The Superintendent shall apply for additional waivers as needed in compliance with state law.
